Elder Care Program

Course Summary: The Elder Care course provides students with foundational knowledge and practical skills to support the daily needs, safety, and well-being of older adults. Designed for individuals interested in care-giving—whether professionally or for family members—this course covers essential topics such as age-related physical and cognitive changes, communication strategies, infection control, mobility assistance, nutrition, medication awareness, and compassionate support techniques.

Students will learn best practices for maintaining dignity and independence in older adults while recognizing signs of common health concerns. Through instructor-led demonstrations, hands-on practice, and real-world scenarios, participants build confidence in delivering safe, respectful, and effective care.

This course is ideal for entry-level caregivers, family caregivers, or anyone interested in beginning a career in elder care or preparing for advanced training in health or human services.

Course Highlights:

- **Understanding Aging**
Learn about physical, emotional, and cognitive changes associated with aging.
- **Communication Skills**
Develop effective and compassionate communication techniques for working with older adults and their families.
- **Daily Living Support**
Practice safe assistance with mobility, personal hygiene, dressing, and nutrition.
- **Safety & Infection Control**
Gain essential knowledge on preventing falls, maintaining a safe environment, and following proper infection-control procedures.
- **Medication Awareness**
Understand common medications used by older adults and how to support safe practices (non-clinical overview).
- **Chronic Conditions Overview**
Recognize signs and symptoms of common age-related health conditions.
- **Dementia & Memory Care Basics**
Learn strategies for supporting individuals with dementia or cognitive decline.
- **Hands-On Skills Practice**
Participate in demonstrations and real-world care-giving scenarios to build confidence.
- **Compassionate Care Approach**
Emphasize respect, dignity, and person-centered support in every aspect of care-giving.

- Entry-level healthcare workers seeking foundational training.
- Family members caring for an aging parent, relative, or loved one.
- Community members who want to better support older adults in their lives

Terms and Conditions

The Gavilan College Community Education Department has implemented a payment plan option for students enrolling in our fee-based, not for college credit Certified Phlebotomist Training Program. This plan requires that full payment of the program fees be paid in 2 installments. A deposit of \$600.00 + \$100.00 payment plan fee = \$700 is due upon registration (see schedule above). The balance is then paid over 1 more installment.
