Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) Program

Prepare for a rewarding and fast-paced career in emergency medical services! Our EMT course is designed to equip students with the fundamental knowledge and hands-on skills required to provide life-saving care in critical situations. This course meets the national requirements for EMT training and is the first step toward a career in emergency response.

Requirements:

- Must be at least 18 years old
- High School diploma or equivalent
- Current CPR/BLS certification
- Mandatory Orientation on July 25, 2026

Physical Requirements:

- Students enrolling in the Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) course must meet the following physical demands to ensure safety and readiness for emergency situations:
 - Lift and carry up to 125 pounds, occasionally up to 250 pounds with assistance
 - Stoop, bend, kneel, squat, and crawl in various emergency environments
 - Stand and walk for extended periods during clinical and field training

Elder Care Skills & Support Program

This program is designed to train caregivers, healthcare students, and family members in providing effective hands-on care to older adults. This caregiving-focused curriculum covers essential daily care techniques, and those with disabilities, physical health monitoring, mobility assistance, basic rehabilitation, and mental health support strategies. Each session features interactive lessons, and hands-on demonstrations. The program emphasizes improving the quality of promoting person-centered care, and equipping caregivers with the skills needed to assist with conditions such as Alzheimer's, dementia, chronic illness, and age-related physical or cognitive decline.

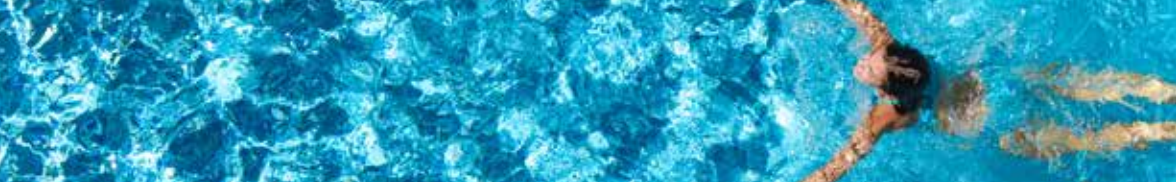
