The Child Development Teacher Permit, which requires 16 additional units in general education beyond the certificate, allows students to teach in state or federally funded child care and development programs.

# Median Salary in the Bay Area \$71,537 per year

This degree or certificate is designed to prepare students to enter the Heating, Air Conditioning, and Refrigeration Technology field. Instruction includes both theory and practical application with heating, air conditioning, and refrigeration machinery and with electrical equipment, as well as the related mathematics. Students receiving the degree will have the knowledge and skills essential for employment in a variety of careers; including AC Technicians, Heating Technicians, Refrigeration Technicians, HVAC Mechanics, and HVAC Installers.

Students will learn how to problem solve, troubleshoot and perform maintenance and repair on residential and commercial heating, air conditioning, and refrigeration systems. Interpret and process wiring and pipe diagrams. Demonstrate safety, honesty, and integrity when dealing with customers and employers and when performing mechanical and electrical installations of heating, air conditioning, and refrigeration systems.

This course will cover gas furnaces, electric furnaces and oil heat. The students will learn about split system applications and package unit applications.

#### **HVAC 206 HVAC Controls 4 units**

Students will study theory, application, and operation of Heating, Ventilating, and Air Conditioning control systems; including electric, pneumatic, solid state, and digital control systems.

#### **Assessment Process**

- Please contact our support staff to fill out an application or you can fill out one online here: www.gavilan.edu/welcome/index.php
- Our staff will schedule an appointment with you for an assessment and orientation session.
- Several things will happen during the assessment and orientation session. First, you will receive information about our program. Then, you will be interviewed and receive a score. Next you will discuss your options with our placement specialists to help you choose classes that meet your needs and goals.
- Our counselor is available at every assessment event to help with any of your concerns or questions.

During the first week of class, ESL instructors assess students to check that they are placed in the appropriate class. Sometimes, the assessment shows that a student is in a class that is too high or too low for their level. If this happens, the department chairs and Continuing Education Counselor discuss moving the student to another class. The team talks with the student so that any changes fit the student's goals and English level. This level adjustment happens with very few students, less than 5% per term.






